



PUBLIC NOTICE

NATIONAL FORESTRY AUTHORITY (NFA) wishes to inform all her esteemed clients and the general public that were granted permits, licenses and offers for the sustainable utilization and management of any part of any Central Forest Reserves in Uganda pursuant to Section 41 of the National Forestry and Tree Planting Act No.8 of 2003 and any of the provisions of the repealed Forests Act Cap 146 to show cause within 14 days from the date of this notice as to why their licenses and permits should not be terminated and their offers revoked. Failure to show cause within 14 days will automatically terminate or revoke the licenses or offers respectively.

This notice applies to the following categories;

- Individuals, Legal entities and Associations that are in possession of valid licenses but have not fully complied with the covenants reserved therein.
- Individuals, Legal Entities and Associations that were granted offers but have not complied with conditions reserved therein and neither obtained licenses.

NFA further notifies individuals, Legal entities and Associations that have been in possession of permits and licenses that have since expired due to effluxion of time and have not been renewed to vacate the forest reserves in accordance with the provisions of the license and permit agreements.
